There is also an adjoined, enclosed serving room equipped with air conditioning, microwave, refrigerator, freezer, and serving window.

The cost to enter the park is \$2.00/person, children 2 y.o. and under are free. The price of admission includes the picnic tables, playgrounds, walking trails a person can bike on, fishing streams, and a large water area. we recommend that you bring a folding chair. Below is a map of how to get there once you're in the park. There will be no services at HLBC that day, so please come join us in fellowship and bring someone with you.
