- I ordered a chicken and an egg from Amazon..... I'll let you know.

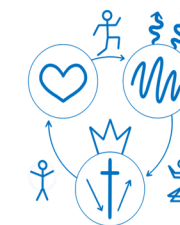

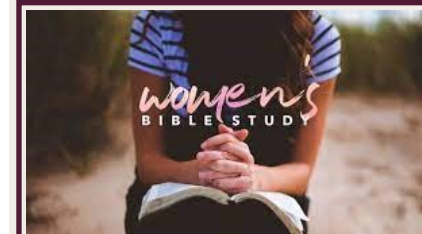
